

## An Interfaith Intercultural Event: "How do we live together?"

We are organising a conference at the Hallam University on the 28<sup>th</sup> of November 2007 between 19:00 - 21:00.

The conference will emphasise the necessity of interfaith and intercultural dialogue in promoting cohesion and universal human values such as respect, peace and tolerance.
