## ***Faith Awareness***

'Issues' / possible actions	Rank
<b>Faith awareness resources</b> Producing and sharing written resources (eg booklet of faiths in the city, web-based articles, etc), providing faith awareness training.	
<b>Faith group visits / Sheffield Open Door week</b> Support faith groups (individually or a co-ordinated programme) to hold a series of open days, festivals and events open to the public.	
<b>Sight and sounds project- images of faith communities</b> Capturing images (photo and video) of the life of faith communities within the City eg DVD, web-based resources - for possible use with Schools, faith groups, and statutory agencies.	
<b>Multi-faith act of remembrance</b> Produce resources for / co-ordinate a multi-faith act of remembrance in the City, working alongside key partners.	

## ***Supporting faith communities***

'Issues' / possible actions	Rank
<b>Faith workers training / How your city works training</b> Providing training for voluntary and paid faith workers around governance, community development, and understanding / influencing local decision making.	
<b>Neighbourhood based work</b> Helping faith groups in specific neighbourhoods to work together to identify and address issues of local concern.	
<b>Multi-faith space in city centre</b> Research potential provision of a multi-faith space (including Muslim Prayer space) in Sheffield City Centre. Link with appropriate partners and explore possible ways forward.	
<b>Women in faith</b> Support women in faith groups to meet together to encourage mutual understanding and to identify and address issues of common concern. Possible links with work taking place regionally.	
<b>Young People's project</b> Development of a young peoples inter faith project, led by young people. Support young people in faith groups to meet together to encourage mutual understanding and to identify and address issues of common concern. Possible links with work taking place regionally.

### ***Linking with others***

'Issues' / possible actions	Rank
<p><b>Campaigning against human trafficking</b> Raising awareness of and supporting campaigns (eg CHASTE). Working with local police and partners.</p>	
<p><b>Community cohesion</b> Making sure that faith communities are heard in national and local strategies and supporting local faith based projects that build cohesion.</p>	
<p><b>Environmental issues</b> Promoting environmental awareness and good practice in faith communities. Linking with faith based environmental campaigns.</p>	
<p><b>EU Migrants</b> Identify needs of new communities and potential issues or obstacles. Learn from faith groups already working with these communities.</p>	
<p><b>Mixed faith couples</b> Provide training and resources to support mixed faith couples and guidelines for statutory organisations and faith groups.</p>	
<p><b>Spiritual Needs in health and social care</b> Working with care services eg Mental Health, vulnerable adults etc to help take account of the spiritual needs of service users.</p>	
<p><b>Spiritual needs in the workplace</b> Support / advise on the provision of faith needs in the workplace. Link with key partners (eg South Yorkshire Workplace Chaplaincy).</p>
